### Jeremiah 6:13-15, 7:4-10 (NRSV)

6: <sup>13</sup>For from the least to the greatest of them, everyone is greedy for unjust gain; and from prophet to priest, everyone deals falsely. <sup>14</sup>They have treated the wound of my people carelessly, saying, "Peace, peace," when there is no peace. <sup>15</sup>They acted shamefully, they committed abomination; yet they were not ashamed, they did not know how to blush. Therefore they shall fall among those who fall; at the time that I punish them, they shall be overthrown, says the Lord. . . . 7: <sup>4</sup>Do not trust in these deceptive words: "This is the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord." <sup>5</sup>For if you truly amend your ways and your doings, if you truly act justly one with another, <sup>6</sup> if you do not oppress the alien, the orphan, and the widow, or shed innocent blood in this place, and if you do not go after other gods to your own hurt, <sup>7</sup>then I will dwell with you in this place, in the land that I gave of old to your ancestors forever and ever. <sup>8</sup>Here you are, trusting in deceptive words to no avail. <sup>9</sup>Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, make offerings to Baal, and go after other gods that you have not known, <sup>10</sup> and then come and stand before me in this house, which is called by my name, and say, "We are safe!" ---only to go on doing all these abominations?

# Jeremías 6:13-15, 7:4-10 (RVR1995)

6: <sup>13</sup>»Desde el más chico de ellos hasta el más grande, cada uno sigue la avaricia; y desde el profeta hasta el sacerdote, todos son engañadores. <sup>14</sup>Curan la herida de mi pueblo con liviandad, diciendo: "Paz, paz", ipero no hay paz! <sup>15</sup>¿Se han avergonzado de haber hecho abominación? ### Jeremiah 14:11-16 (NRSV)

<sup>11</sup>The Lord said to me: Do not pray for the welfare of this people, <sup>12</sup>Although they fast, I do not hear their cry, and although they offer burnt offering and grain offering, I do not accept them; but by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence I consume them. <sup>13</sup>Then I said: "Ah, Lord God! Here are the prophets saying to them, 'You shall not see the sword, nor shall you have famine, but I will give you true peace in this place."<sup>14</sup>And the Lord said to me: The prophets are prophesying lies in my name; I did not send them, nor did I command them or speak to them. They are prophesying to you a lying vision, worthless divination, and the deceit of their own minds. <sup>15</sup>Therefore thus says the Lord concerning the prophets who prophesy in my name though I did not send them, and who say, "Sword and famine shall not come on this land": By sword and famine those prophets shall be consumed. <sup>16</sup>And the people to whom they prophesy shall be thrown out into the streets of Jerusalem, victims of famine and sword. There shall be no one to bury them-themselves, their wives, their sons, and their daughters. For I will pour out their wickedness upon them.

# Jeremías 14:11-16 (RVR1995)

<sup>11</sup>Y me dijo Jehová: «No ruegues por el bien de este pueblo. <sup>12</sup>Cuando ayunen, yo no escucharé su clamor, y cuando ofrezcan holocausto y ofrenda no los aceptaré, sino que los consumiré con espada, con hambre y con pestilencia.» <sup>13</sup>Yo dije: «iAh, ah, Señor, Jehová!, mira que los profetas les dicen: "No veréis espada ni habrá hambre entre vosotros, sino que en este lugar os daré paz verdadera."» <sup>14</sup>Me dijo entonces Jehová: «Falsamente profetizan los profetas en mi nombre. # Jeremiah 28:5-9 (NRSV)

<sup>5</sup>Then the prophet Jeremiah spoke to the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests and all the people who were standing in the house of the Lord; <sup>6</sup>and the prophet Jeremiah said, "Amen! May the Lord do so; may the Lord fulfill the words that you have prophesied, and bring back to this place from Babylon the vessels of the house of the Lord, and all the exiles. <sup>7</sup>But listen now to this word that I speak in your hearing and in the hearing of all the people. <sup>8</sup>The prophets who preceded you and me from ancient times prophesied war, famine, and pestilence against many countries and great kingdoms. <sup>9</sup>As for the prophet who prophesies peace, when the word of that prophet comes true, then it will be known that the Lord has truly sent the prophet."

### Jeremías 28:5-9 (RVR1995)

<sup>5</sup>Entonces respondió el profeta Jeremías al profeta Hananías delante de los sacerdotes y delante de todo el pueblo que estaba en la casa de Jehová. <sup>6</sup>Dijo el profeta Jeremías: «iAmén, así lo haga Jehová!
